Each year, the Booking Office spends time following up members who are overdue on completing payment for bookings, which comes at a considerable cost to a non-profit co-operative.

Bookings need to be fully paid no later than 1 month prior to the booking start date. Our Booking Terms & Conditions states that "A booking may be cancelled and the reservation removed from the booking system if full payment is not received within 1 month of the start date of the booking".

All bookings receive a reminder email from the booking system at the point payment is due. Please ensure all your bookings are paid in accordance with the above requirements. The Board have determined that in order to reduce unnecessary Booking Office overheads, if you have not completed payment for a booking by the due date, you will receive 1 courtesy reminder. If payment is not completed within 48 hours from that time, your booking may be cancelled and any deposit paid forfeited.

The May 2017 Skilib work party at Mt. Buller was held on the weekend of May 5 and 6. A smaller group of around 14 members attended to a range of tasks to prepare the lodge for the coming winter season.

As well as the normal work party job of stacking 5 cubic metres of firewood, we completed a total clean of the kitchen, painting of some walls as needed, cleaning of scuff marks on other walls, thorough clean of the bedrooms, bathrooms and living areas, complete cleanup of the possum mess in the members loft, together with some woodwork to seal off various gaps, and replacement of smoke detector batteries.

This was followed on Saturday evening by pre-dinner nibbles around the fire and a roast dinner and dessert which was enjoyed by all after a tiring day. Thanks to all those who participated and gave their time.
